COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Accelerated Spanish[®] courses are divided into 12 levels of 28 hours each.

Level 1A and level 1B. For complete beginners.

Development of basic skills: comprehension, speaking, reading and writing. Introduction to the present indicative and other elementary grammatical components.

Level 2A and level 2B. Basic level.

Continued development of basic skills: comprehension, speaking, reading and writing. Introduction to more indicative tenses and other elementary grammatical components.

Level 3A and level 3B. Low intermediate level.

Development of language skills: comprehension, speaking, reading and writing with classroom exercises. Introduction to the subjunctive and more grammatical components.

Level 4A and level 4B. High intermediate level.

Continued development of language skills. Comprehension, speaking, reading and writing with short reading and compositions assignments. Introduction to more tenses and applications of the subjunctive and more grammatical components.

Level 5A and level 5B. Advanced level.

Oral and written compositions based upon readings of texts emphasizing Spanish culture and literary vocabulary. Exercises in syntax and introductory phonetics.

Level 6A and level 6B. Expert level.

Classroom discussion and conversation in Spanish about selected topics of Spanish and Latin American culture. Emphasis on vocabulary-building and acquisition of oral communication skills.
